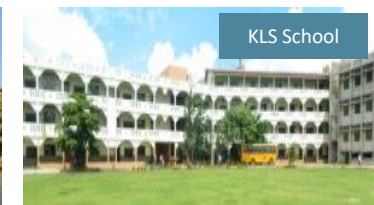

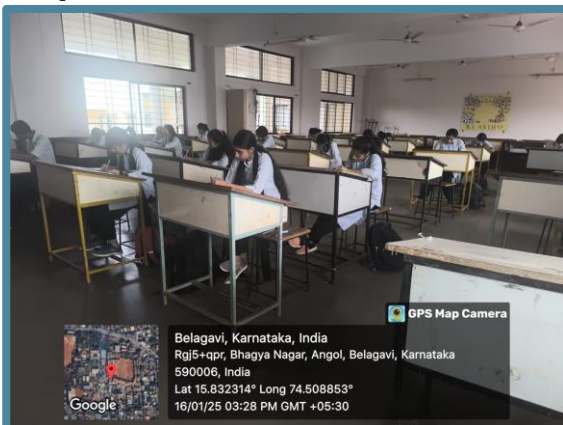

#### KLS VPP Celebrates 76th Republic Day with Patriotic Fervor



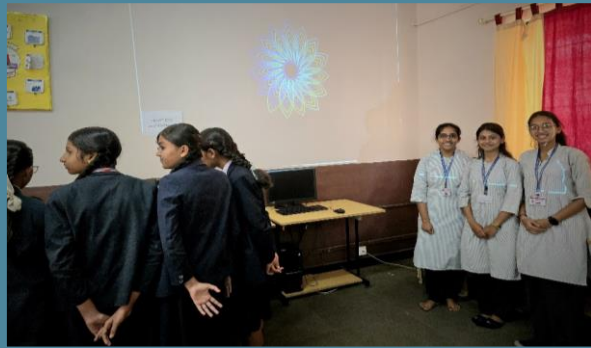

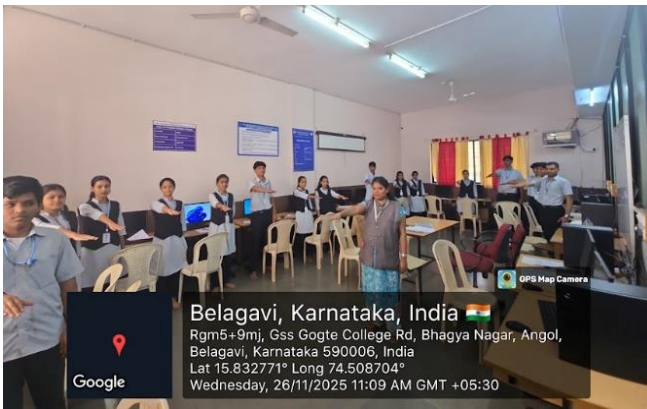
### Tiranga FC Emerges Victorious in Football Tournament at KLS VPP
